Donna Buss introduced the CEO of the Midway Museum, RADM "Mac" McLaughlin who brought us up-to-date on the future plans for the USS Midway Museum. The Midway is the most visited retired ship in the world and is on very financially firm footing. As an asset for the San Diego community the three benefits of the USS Midway are its location, the education programs, and the "after hours" events. Midway hosted over 60,000 students last year and held over 700 "after hours" events. Their goal is to tell America's story through the Midway and to that end their Foundation has endowed a chair in Military History at SDSU, and they're building a five-acre Veterans' Park surrounding the USS Midway. By the way, "Mac" announced, for your ears only, that our own Jon Ryan will be honored as "Volunteer of the Year!"
