Shelter Box is one of the really great projects that we support and **Tom Mitchell** invited Tim McCully to bring us up to date on the Shelter Box program. Proving the power of Rotary, one man in one Club in England saw a need and developed the Shelter Box program in 2000. From that humble beginning Shelter Box has helped out in over 300 disasters in 100 countries and has helped over 1,000,000 families. A Shelter Box is region specific and includes a family-sized tent, a stove, water purification, sleeping gear, and something for the children. Shelter Box depends on local Rotarians to make sure that the boxes get to the proper families and not to the black market. Since 2010 the Rotary Club of Coronado has donated \$73,900 to Shelter Box, and we don't think that includes the \$2000 donation **President Tami** presented to Tim today.
