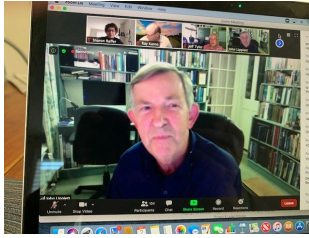

Program

Our guest zoomed in from the UK as **Jeff Tyler** introduced RADM John Lippiett of the Royal Navy for a wonderful discussion of Henry VIII's flagship "The Mary Rose." The Mary Rose was a 150 foot, 500 ton first warship of Henry's fleet. She was built in 1509 and fought in three wars before being swamped defending Portsmouth harbor and sinking in July, 1545. The wreck was located in the 1960s and raised in 1982. After a unique and thorough cleaning they built the museum AROUND the wreck. 25,000 underwater hours have produced 27,000 artifacts that tell the story of the Mary Rose. There are cannon, long bows, bowls, mugs, a dog skeleton, bones, and even a backgammon board and dice! The Mary Rose is in good company "docked" with ADM Nelson's HMS Victory and HMS Warrior, the first iron-hulled warship. www.maryrose.org to see it all.
