**Pandemic President Robin** introduced Heather Conley, Senior VP of the Center for Strategic and International Studies, who zoomed in from near the Land of Oz in Chevy Chase, MD. We had an interesting discussion on Brexit and the ramifications for the United Kingdom, Ireland, the European Union, and even the United States. The UK joined the EU in 1973 during a time of economic stagnation, but voted themselves out 43 years later due to immigration issues in the EU. The withdrawal agreement centered on three issues: 1) the UK had to pay the EU \$39 billion pounds, 2) citizens' rights for those Europeans living in the UK and British citizens living in the EU, and, 3) Northern Ireland. Too much is tied up in the Northern Ireland issue for the **Humble Scribe** to unpack, but Heather thinks the UK may not be the UK in the future.
