### *Notes from the Substitute Scribe*

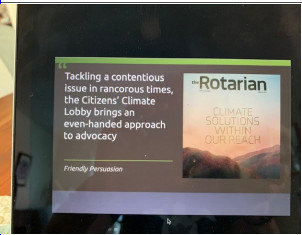

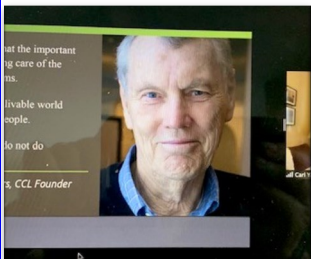
