President Robin introduced a Bruin/Trojan, and LA Wilshire Rotarian, Mark Benthien of the So Cal Earthquake Center for the seven steps to earthquake safety. Mark is a San Diegan born at Grossmont Hospital, went to Monte Vista HS, UCLA, and USC for his masters'. His dad was in Chula Vista Rotary for years. He pointed out that while Coronado isn't really in line for "The Big One," a 6.9 magnitude quake is possible on the Rose Canyon Fault. Coronado's problem would be being cut off.
