Pat Starke introduced Coronado icon Brad Willis for a discussion of his time in Afghanistan as an NBC war correspondent, his work on the Coronado Arts Commission, and as a supporter of the League of Wives Memorial. Brad first went to Afghanistan in 1986 during the Soviet occupation and brought pictures of the children and the thought that there's no way the Soviets could prevail. As Coronado's Video Storyteller he focuses on the incredibly interesting people of Coronado, including 100 year old Tom Rice who parachuted onto the beach in front of the Hotel Del to celebrate his 100th birthday. Brad introduced Christina Slentz of the League of Wives Memorial who told us about the history and how the Rotary Four Way Test applies to the Memorial.
