Ivan Dunn introduced his old Naval Intel colleague and now Rabbi Arnie Resnicoff who spoke to us on "Chaplains, Faith, and Foxholes." Arnie and Ivan both served under Admiral Ed Martin, our old Rotary pal. And, Rabbi Resnicoff survived the 1983 Lebanon Marine barracks bombing. He explained that military chaplains are staff officers and non-combatants.
