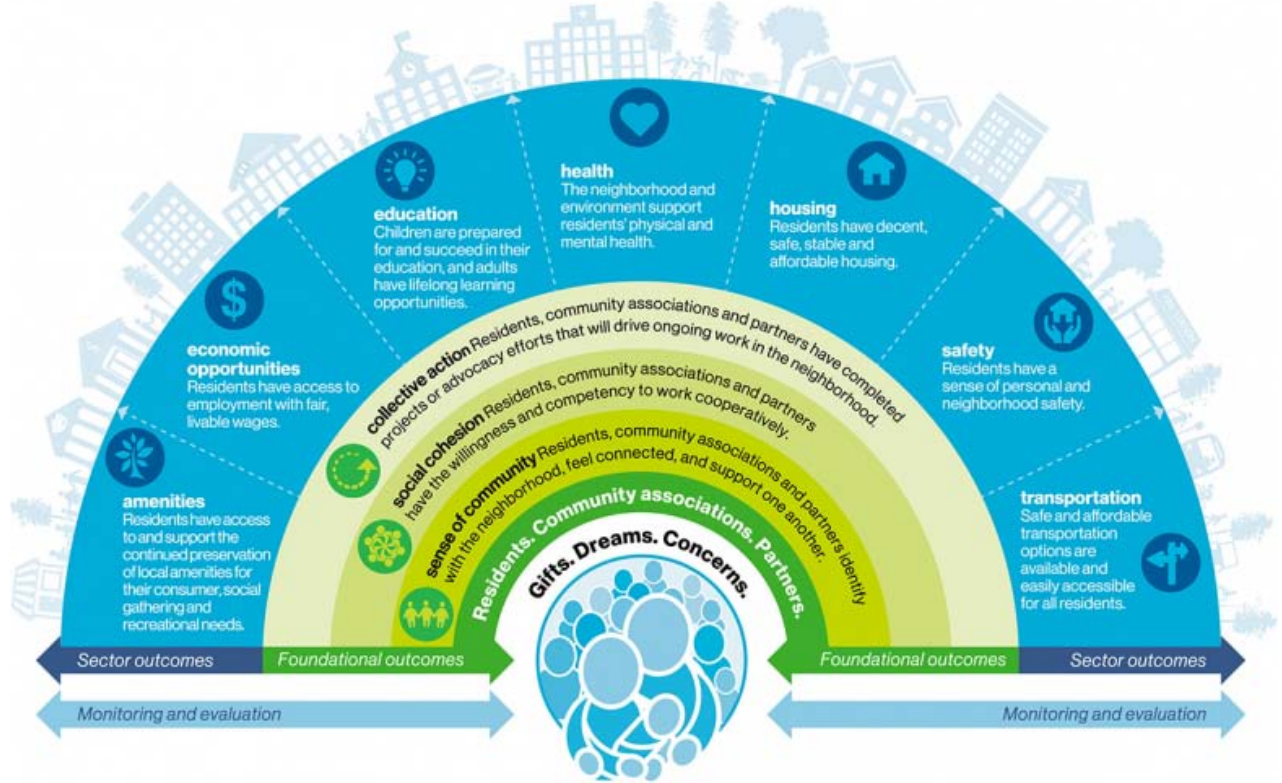
Habitat of the St. Vrain Valley is one of only ten programs in the nation that is complementing the work of building or updating homes, with neighborhood revitalization.
