- Charlene and Larry will celebrate their 51 st with family all around, and Charlene's favorite team the Green Bay Packers are the NFC North Champions.



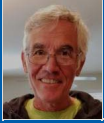

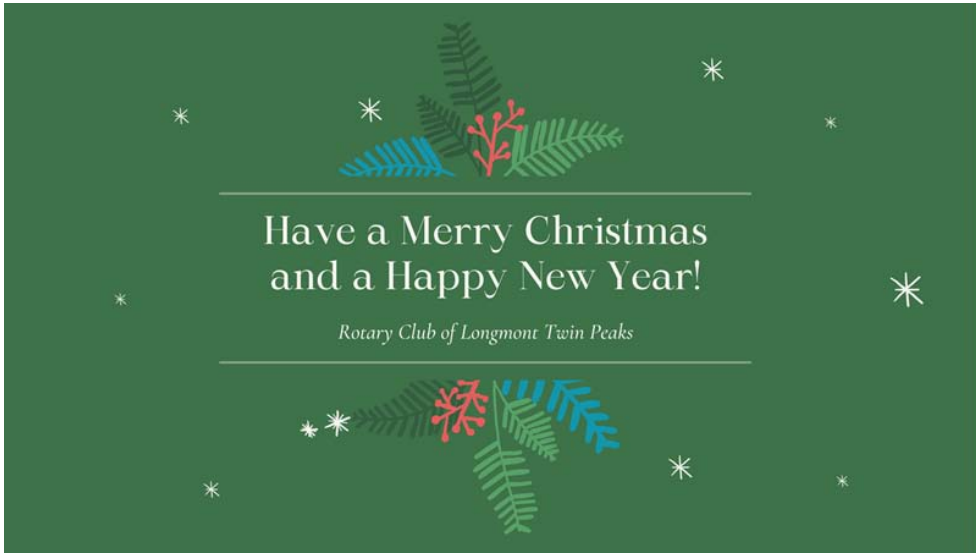
