Today is ♦Opening Day♦ for Baseball ♦ Rick Kalamaya tested our baseball knowledge and shared wisdom from George Carlin regarding the difference between baseball and football.

Programs

Today♦s guest speaker was Stephen Tidd, Director of Clinical Support services at UC Health, Longs Peak Hospital. Stephen presented information about the detailed ♦Emergency Operations Plan,♦ which is already in place when any sort of disaster or pandemic occurs. The Emergency Operations Plan provides the organizational structure, policies, and procedures to be followed in terms of decision-making, communication, logistics, staffing, security and more. Stephen spoke about the ♦all hazards approach♦ to preparation, noting the ♦Hazard Vulnerability Assessment♦ tool used to rate the probability and preparedness of the hospital to respond to specific types of disasters/emergencies.

Referring to the Pandemic Flu Plan, Stephen spoke about how the emergency operations plan outlines establishing the Incident Command Center and guides how the hospital continues to be operational as it deals with an influx of patients. In this pandemic, there has been an increased need for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for medical personnel and emergency first responders. Stephen explained the use of masks, face shields, gowns, and gloves. He also described the proper procedures for ♦donning and doffing♦ when putting on and taking off the protective equipment. There have been conservation efforts, such as limiting access to PPE and limiting the amount of patient contact, that would require PPE. He also noted some developments in the reprocessing of N95 masks so that the masks can be cleaned and worn again by the same person. He did not speak of shortages, but rather referred to building up reserves as manufacturing has increased to meet demand.

Stephen noted that there are metrics identified as ♦triggers♦ in place which if met, will re-activate the Incident Command and emergency operations plan. In conclusion, Stephen reminded us to wash our hands often, wear a mask, observe social distancing, and stay home when you can.
