### **Guest Speaker:** Ross Malone

Ross Malone has taught in Missouri for over thirty years and, since retiring, has worked as a radio host and published nineteen books about Missouri. His Missouri history column *Back in the Day* is published weekly in newspapers across the state.

His book, *Missouri's Forgotten Heroes*, is his best seller and has been selected by the Ozarks Writers League as this year's Best Book of the Year. Described by one newspaper as the Czar of Missouri History, Ross is a frequent guest on radio and television stations in Missouri and has been a guest on the Westwood One Radio Network, as well as on the Armed Forces Network Overseas.

Ross highlighted several excerpts from his book, *Missouri's Forgotten Heroes*.
