What is ZOOM???



Ok...so you have heard about ZOOM in this bulletin and maybe have seen it elsewhere. What in the world is ZOOM???

Simply put, ZOOM is one of the newer methods to connect in a 'virtual' world. It allows folks from wherever to get together online at the same time and share ideas, discuss things, etc. It is very similar to GoToMeeting, WebEx, Microsoft Teams or other virtual meeting platforms.

For the average person, there is NO CHARGE for ZOOM. You can go to [ZOOM.us](https://zoom.us) and select PLANS & PRICING from the top and select BASIC PERSONAL MEETING FREE. You create a login (usually your email) and a password to set up your account, and away you go! If you do not wish to download the program, you will need to add and enable an app on your computer/laptop/tablet to connect.

You can also use a telephone and call in using one of the numbers provided. For security, if you dial in, you would also need to enter the password given. If you were to use your computer/laptop/tablet, clicking on the link provided would take you directly to the meeting.
