Recent Speaker

Club member and administrator at COMC Ashley McDonnell gave the group a COVID update. She showed us the current swabs used to take the tests and advised results take about 3-4. They have some of the equipment necessary for the rapid tests (with results in 15 minutes) but waiting on additional supplies.

Because of a Grant they applied for back in February they are able to give free tests to anyone that wants one. If you have insurance, your insurance will be billed but COMC will pick up any co-pay or out of pocket expense making it free to consumers. Drive-thru testing available at 5PM - 7PM at COMC locations as shown below:

Tuesday - Osage Beach
Wednesday - Richland
Thursday - Camdenton

The antigen testing is a blood draw and not picked up by the grant. It is believe that a person that has had COVID will have the antigen for about 90 days. After 90 days it beleived they can get the virus again.
