The county has received requests for mask orders but they have not implemented one due to the mobility of the population.

The county has received grant money from the Cares Act to offset Covid related costs. They have used the funds for the justice department, improved radios for

cities and fire districts; worked with Chambers regarding food banks, animal shelters, homeless shelters, summer food delivery services and medications to vulnerable residents.

Sales tax revenue was down 14% in the spring but year-to-date has greater than 7% increase. There has also been a huge increase in real estatate sales and we will see a ripple effect on the economy from these sales for the next several years.
