Matt Kelly, bartender and mixologist, gave a brief history on cocktails along with making several hot toddies to take the chill off us this winter. He started the evening out with making the festive Celebrate cocktail that allows the bartender to get a tasty libation quickly into each guest's hand as a party begins.

Members who gave a donation of food or money were presented with the makings of a variation of the Celebration Cocktail from Patrick Prenger. Ric Telthorst emceed the Naughty game, where we found out that Carla Ahrens could claim to be the Nicest party goer that night. Kit Freudenberg was our Naughtiest member who played. The evening was closed out with a beautiful Christmas carol sung by Nicole Slusser using her wonderful voice.

#### **Celebrate**

- 1/2 ounce pear brandy
  - 1/4 ounce fino sherry
  - 1/4 ounce cinnamon syrup
  - 6 ounces sparkling wine
- Add brandy, sherry, and cinnamon syrup glass, then add sparkling wine.

#### **Cinnamon Syrup**

- 500 grams simple syrup
  - 10 grams crushed cinnamon
  - .1 gram kosher salt
- cook for 2 hours at 145 degrees.

#### **Simple Syrup**

- 250 grams of white sugar
  - 250 grams of boiling water
- Stir to dissolve sugar. Put into a container and chill.

#### **Hot Toddy - Apple Brandy**

- 1-1/2 ounces apple brandy
- slice of lemon (optional: studded with whole cloves)
- nutmeg

#### **Hot Toddy - Cinnamon Tequila**

- 4 ounces hot water
- Heat glass. Add brandy to warm glass. Add lemon slice. Pour in 4 ounces of hot water. Top with nutmeg.

#### **Hot Toddy - Cinnamon Tequila**

- 1-1/2 ounces Cinnamon Tequila
  - 4 ounces hot water
  - Orange twist
- Heat glass. Add tequila to warm glass. Pour in 4 ounces of hot water. Express orange twist over the glass.

#### **Cinnamon Tequila**

- Add a 3-inch stick of cinnamon to a bottle of tequila. Allow to sit for 24-hours. Remove cinnamon stick.

#### **Irish Coffee**

- 1-1/2 ounces Irish whiskey
- 1/2 ounce Brown sugar simple syrup
- 4 ounces hot coffee

#### **Fresh whipped cream**

- Heat glass. Add whiskey and brown sugar simple syrup to the glass. Add coffee. Top with whipped cream.

#### **Brown Sugar Simple Syrup**

- 250 grams of brown sugar
  - 250 grams of boiling water
- Stir to dissolve sugar. Put into a container and chill.
