On August 13 we are excited to welcome Carrie Richardson, the Executive Director of Leadership Springfield, to Springfield Metro. Prior to joining Leadership Springfield, she spent a decade in health care administration as Chief Operating Officer for a rural tri-state health system and several years in nonprofit development and grant writing.

With a bachelors in communications from Drury University, Carrie is currently completing her master in nonprofit and civic leadership at Drury. She has been married for 16 years.
