Nicole Brown, Executive Director, began working with Sculpture Walk Springfield upon its creation in 2014. Working with community partners, Nicole has facilitated the design of the first rotating public art campaign in Springfield, coordinated educational opportunities for children, obtained non-profit status and experienced significant growth in the first five years.

With a 10-year background in not-for-profit, grant writing, marketing, public relations, and arts advocacy, Nicole brings her passion for bettering her community and working toward a *museum without walls with access to all* in Springfield. Nicole graduated from Missouri State University in 2005 with a Bachelor of Arts in Art History.

Nicole fell in love with sculpture upon discovering Gian Lorenzo Bernini. He was one of the first artists able to depict human emotion by displaying characters in intense psychological states. *Ecstasy of Saint Teresa* is a perfect example of a large-scale work that forces the viewer to feel something while giving them a sense of place. Nicole's hope for Sculpture Walk Springfield is to give Springfield a similar feeling through public sculpture and placemaking.
