Thank you for joining us last week as we heard from Adam Conkright discussing Democratic Lotteries. This week, Peter Nierengarten will speak on the Culture Arts Corridor here in Fayetteville. The Cultural Arts Corridor will link cultural institutions including the Walton Arts Center, TheatreSquared's new performing arts venue, Community Creative Center, Fayetteville Public Library, and the University of Arkansas's Art and Design District and will activate the outdoor environment, the Fay Jones Woods, between Dickson and Prairie Streets with amenities that will enhance the experience for city residents and visitors alike. Be prepared to learn more about this plan for the city.

Big thank you to Chuck Culver and his 'team gratitude': Diane Warren, Emily Mizell, Miles Boyce, and Mary Alice-Serafini for preparing thank yous for the Washington County Detention Center staff. Early on in the pandemic, Chuck and his team identified first responders to covid-19 who may not have received recognition or benefits despite working closely with vulnerable populations. After our first success in giving thanks to Washington Regional custodial staff, the Detention Center was chosen as the second site. Our detention center workers have been required to continue to work at the jail throughout the entire pandemic, even while workers and inmates have contracted the virus. Rotarians wrote thank you notes for each work, and a gift card was included in each envelope.
