Program: Meet Our McLain Partners - Keeje Elliott with Dream Center

Trai and Keeje Elliott are marketplace ministers of the gospel using practical tools to help those who feel they are stuck and over life to overcome their past and press forward into their future. They are from Florida, but are living currently in Tulsa, OK while Trai finishes his bachelors degree in evangelism and outreach at Oral Roberts University. They currently lead the Overcomers program at the Tulsa Dream Center for 9th-12th grade students. The purpose of the program is to give students a positive outlook on influencing their identity, with hopes that from there they will understand that they can overcome all of the circumstances of their families and excel into greatness.

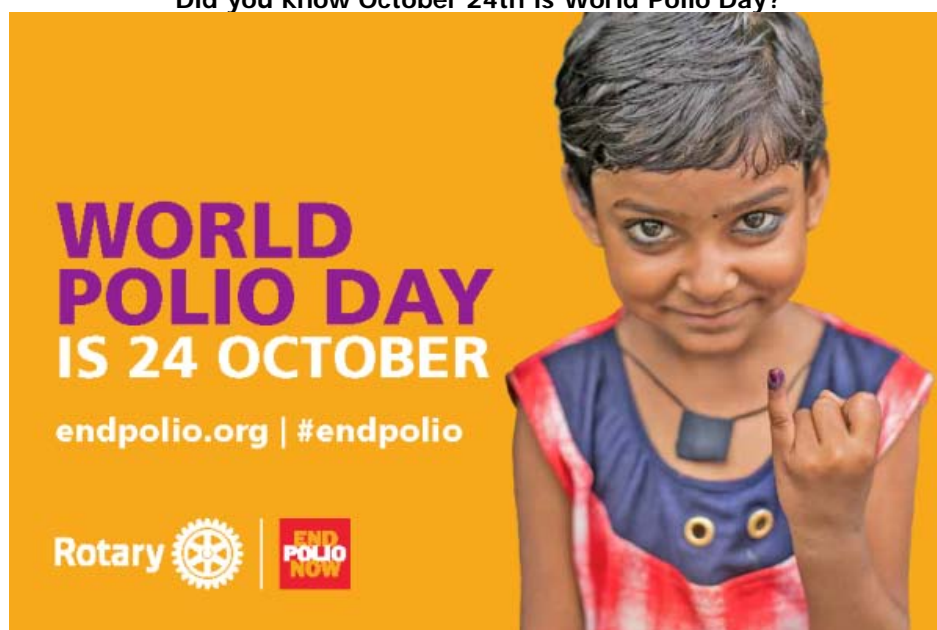

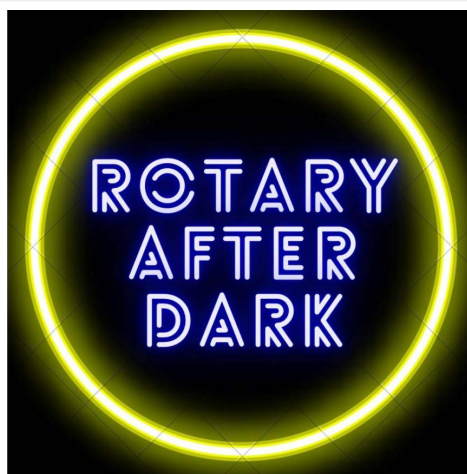

Rotary Spotlight: American Wheelchair Mission

The Rotary District 6110 wheelchair project is alive and well. For the past 18 years, the Springdale Rotary Club has partnered with other clubs and the District to purchase and deliver wheelchairs around the world to those that need one but cannot afford one. Since we started this project, we have been able to purchase over 10,000 wheelchairs to provide mobility to those in need.

There are a lot of things that we take for granted, such as pre-natal care, and technological advancements, that are not as common elsewhere in the world. The results are birth defects, and disabilities among children and adults. We have been able to make distribution trips to over 20 locations in Mexico, and Central America, to personally see the miracle of mobility in action.

We are currently in the process of planning a trip to Mexico City in the spring of 2022 and any Rotarian is invited to go. You can get more info at our booth during District Conference September 18 in Eureka Springs.
