POLIO PLUS WORLD POLIO DAY OCTOBER 24th Since 1988, Rotary and our partners have immunized nearly 3 billion children against polio. As of June 2020, Rotary had committed more than \$2.1 billion to global polio eradication, seeking to eliminate the wild poliovirus in the last two countries where it remains endemic and to ensure that it does not return elsewhere.

In 2019-20, program awards, including PolioPlus Partners grants, totaled \$151.8 million.

The Rotary District 6110 wheelchair project is alive and well. For the past 18 years, the Springdale Rotary Club has partnered with other clubs and the District to purchase and deliver wheelchairs around the world to those that need one but cannot afford one. Since we started this project, we have been able to purchase over 10,000 wheelchairs to provide mobility to those in need.


Here's a great 5 minute video of our District at work in Cancun - give it a look: <u>Wheelchair video</u> You can also use this with your club.

There are a lot of things that we take for granted, such as pre-natal care, and technological advancements, that are not as common elsewhere in the world. The results are birth defects, and disabilities among children and adults. We have been able to make distribution trips to over 20 locations in Mexico, and Central America, to personally see the miracle of mobility in action.

We are currently in the process of planning a trip to Mexico City in the spring of 2022 and any Rotarian is invited to go. You can get more info at our booth during District Conference September 18 in Eureka Springs.

Good News!

As we've reported in prior newsletters over the years, malaria has been, and remains, a primary cause of childhood illness and death in sub-Saharan Africa. More than 260,000 African children under the age of five die from malaria annually. In recent years, the World Health Organization (WHO) and its partners have reported stagnation in progress against the deadly disease.

However, in a groundbreaking announcement October 6th, WHO is recommending extensive use of a malaria vaccine called RTS,S for children in sub-Saharan Africa.



WHO's Director-General Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said, "This is a historic moment. The longawaited malaria vaccine for children is a breakthrough for science, child health and malaria control. Using this vaccine on top of existing tools to prevent malaria could save tens of thousands of young lives each year."

"For centuries, malaria has stalked sub-Saharan Africa, causing immense personal suffering," said WHO's Regional Director for Africa, Dr Matshidiso Moeti. "We have long hoped for an effective malaria vaccine and now for the first time, we have such a vaccine recommended for widespread use. Today's recommendation offers a glimmer of hope for the continent which shoulders the heaviest burden of the disease, and we expect many more African children to be protected from malaria and grow into healthy adults."

The pilot conducted revealed that the vaccine is feasible to deliver, has a strong safety profile, doesn't decrease the use of other preventative measures like bed nets, reduced deadly severe malaria by 30%, and is highly cost effective. While there remain many issues in getting this vaccine (and others under development) to the children in need, this is a very encouraging first step in impacting this terrible disease.

More Good News!

In August, with the Ugandan lockdown ravaging their economy, thanks to your generosity, BARHD was able to help the three secondary schools we support. A total of \$45,000 from BARHD's Education Account was wired to the schools to be spent on sustaining their employees. Each school's Board chose the employees and the amounts they'd receive, including teachers, administrative employees, cooks, gardeners and janitors. The notes of thanks received have been heartwarming.

Note: President Museveni has announced he hopes the secondary schools will be able to reopen in January, once most teachers have been vaccinated.
