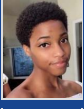

New and Noteworthy



Update: Polio as of 14 October 2020

Take a look at the newly published nOPV2 technical brief that provides a quick summary of the key operational considerations for the use of nOPV2 in outbreak response as a quick reference for EPI managers, immunization focal points, and field staff.

Afghanistan:

One wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) case was reported in Khost province. There have been 52 WPV1 cases reported in 2020 so far while the total number of cases reported in 2019 remains 29.

One WPV1 positive environmental sample was reported in Hirat province.

No case of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus type 2 (cVDPV2) was reported this week. There have been 87 cVDPV2 cases reported in 2020 so far.

11 cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were reported; six in Kabul, one each in Khost, Kunduz and Laghman and two in Nangarhar province.

Pakistan:

Three wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) cases were reported; one in Balochistan and two in Punjab province. There are 77 WPV1 cases reported in 2020 so far while the total number of cases reported in 2019 cases remains 147.

Three WPV1 positive environmental samples were reported; one each in Balochistan, Punjab and Sindh.

No case of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus type 2 (cVDPV2) was reported this week. There have been 64 cVDPV2 cases reported in 2020 so far while the 2019 case count remains 22.

10 cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were reported; one each in Balochistan and Punjab and eight in Sindh

Officially reported WPV cases as of 13 OCTOBER

Total global WPV1 cases in 2020: 129 (compared with 88 for the same period in 2019)

Total global WPV1 cases in 2019: 176

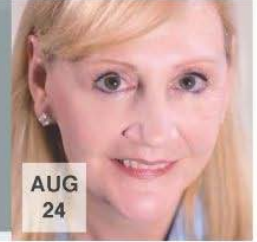

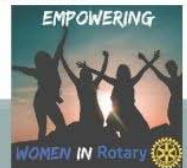
