Program: Jonathan Gobbo - Director of Real Estate Improvements at the Tulsa Airport

Jonathan is the inaugural Direct of Real Estate for Tulsa Airports Improvement Trust, the controlling entity for Tulsa International Airport as well as Richard L. Jones Jr Airport in south Tulsa (we don tike it when people say Jenks Ha!). Jonathan took the position at the end of April in 2019. Some people don trealize that TUL has over 700 acres that we can develop for aeronautical and non-aeronautical purposes due to the fact the airport controls the land between Mingo Rd and Hwy 169. TAIT purchased all that land as they were going to have to build a third parallel runway due to the amount of flights we had in the 70 s. Deregulation in 1978 and with technology advancing so airplanes could land and take off closer together, the capacity for TUL went from 80+% to 30+% and hasn to seen a huge increase since. Since the airport purchased all the land it was finally decided to take the third parallel off the Airport Layout Plan and try to develop it for additional income. That so where Jon comes into the picture. He recently landed a 42 acre development with Amazon as the end user and currently has multiple irons in the fire for more development, both aeronautical and non-aeronautical.

Jonathan s second year with TAIT saw the worst pandemic our world has seen in 100 years and it brought airline travel to a crawl. Because of the pandemic, Jonathan s role with TAIT has only increased as it showed the need to diversify the airport s revenue sources away from being reliant on the airlines. The exciting news is that airline travel is coming back and TUL has added new airlines with new non-stop destinations.

He is a former Southside Rotary member, but now that he works at the airport, the drive was a little far for him on a weekly basis. He is still loving life with his beautiful bride, Keely and their now almost 5 year old (July 31) daughter, Briella and soon to be 2 year old Karsten (June 28). Briella is the absolute sweetest little angel and does no wrong, while Karsten is a boy and we will leave it at that

John grew up in Encino, CA, in the San Fernando Valley. Until 2011 he lived within 30 minutes of the beach, where he enjoyed surfing, scuba diving, ocean fishing, motorcycling, playing football, racquetball, handball, and tennis, leadership in church youth group, and playing guitar.

In college he tried mixing all of the above with a football scholarship at Cal State Univ Northridge, an engineering major, and an active social life. It didn't work, so he lost his scholarship and changed to an accounting major. He held a variety of jobs during college, including custodian, ditch digger, campus police desk clerk, campus information booth attendant, door-to-door curb number sales, Amway sales, and fulltime work in the oilfields during summer vacations. He often slept in his car...or in class.

He married his best friend and "little sister" Jackie in 1972, just before his senior year in college. They returned from their honeymoon to a letter stating that John was scholastically disqualified from CSUN. Panic! He begged his way back in and learned that some of his records had been lost or destroyed in the 1971 San Fernando earthquake. After graduation (which John didn't attend) he went to work for a Los Angeles CPA firm and became tax department manager after 2 years.

John and Jackie moved to Salinas, CA in 1976, where their first child was born prematurely 4 weeks later. The firm grew to 4 offices, 55 employees, and 5 partners with John as tax partner. He earned an MBA in taxation in 1980 (skipping commencement) and was self employed from 1984 to 2009. In 1995 he earned an MA in psychology/counseling (skipping commencement again) and interned as a Marriage & Family Therapist while running his fulltime CPA practice. In 2001 he sold most of his accounting practice and became CFO/Controller of a high-end country club in Monterey for 8 years.

Blood cancer (multiple myeloma) brought John's working life to a screeching halt in 2009. After chemotherapy, radiation, and autologous stem cell transplant he is exceedingly thankful to still be alive, still enjoying life with Jackie and doting over our two happily married children, Jim & Heather, and their 5 extremely loved grandkids, which incidentally were all born after his year of intense cancer therapy. He counts himself a blessed man.


