Ed Johnson has served with the US Army as both a soldier and senior civilian employee. He has been deployed all around the world, including an 18 month deployment as an Infantry squad leader in Iraq.

Ed currently serves as the Public Affairs Officer for the US Army Corps of Engineers (southern half of Kansas, all of Oklahoma and north Texas).

Topics: Communications, Membership, Public Image, Youth Service, RI Programming, The Rotary Foundation, and District 6110


Cost: \$100—Club leadership is encouraged to refund participants upon graduation as an investment for the future.
