In 2006, after three years of preparation, GenScripts opened its first store in midtown Tulsa, at 41st and Hudson next to Panera Bread with this mission: "Relieve the pain of high prescription prices. Provide patients with quality prescriptions at surprisingly affordable prices. Give patients personal counsel on how to save money while assisting them in executing their doctor so care plan. Participate actively in the patient streament and recovery."

In 2012, a new location in Broken Arrow opened at 81st and Garnett next to Sonic, followed by another location in Owasso in 2016 at 96th St. N. and Garnett next to Firehouse Subs.

Mark graduated from the University of Oklahoma with a BS in Pharmacy in 1968, and is a Registered Pharmacist in Oklahoma and Texas.

Topics: Communications, Membership, Public Image, Youth Service, RI Programming, The Rotary Foundation, and District 6110


Cost: \$100—Club leadership is encouraged to refund participants upon graduation as an investment for the future.
