Kevin and Lisa are the parents of one daughter, Jessica, who is married to Landen. They greatly enjoy three grandchildren, Jasen, Madelyn, and Westin.

When not serving in Rotary, they enjoy traveling, enjoying our beautiful country.

Kevin and Lisa are both Paul Harris Fellows and members of the Paul Harris Society. They are Level 1 Major Donors, Bequest Society Members, and District 6110 Leadership Academy Graduates. Kevin was also selected as District 6110 Assistant Governor of the Year in 2017-2018. First, is The Rotary Foundation.

This Foundation is the cornerstone of Rotary. This is the vehicle we use to do �Good in the World. � The Foundation, also know as TRF, has its own President and board of directors.

The other Foundation is the Southside Tulsa Rotary Foundation.

As a member of Tulsa Southside Rotary you are also a member of our Foundation. Southside Tulsa Foundation also has a President and is run by a Board of Directors. Unlike TRF, which is made up of Rotarians from throughout the world, usually Past Rotary International Presidents, our Foundation is made up of Southside Rotarians. The SSRF is used to primarily to fund local projects, but it is not an absolute requirement.

Topics: Communications, Membership, Public Image, Youth Service, RI Programming, The Rotary Foundation, and District 6110


Cost: \$100—Club leadership is encouraged to refund participants upon graduation as an investment for the future.
