Annual Fund-Share - When Rotarians donate to the Foundation and designate the funds to go to the Annual Fund Share, 50% is directed to the World Fund and 50% is directed back to the districts. The World Fund portion pays for worldwide grants and programs and the District Designated Funds are used to fund district projects and to club programs.

Endowment Fund - is a long fund and the donations are invested in perpetuity after a portion is directed to Foundation grants and programs.


The Union Interact club is off to a strong start!

Rotary Spotlight: American Wheelchair Mission by Noel Morris

The Rotary District 6110 wheelchair project is alive and well. For the past 18 years, the Springdale Rotary Club has partnered with other clubs and the District to purchase and deliver wheelchairs around the world to those that need one but cannot afford one.

Since we started this project, we have been able to purchase over 10,000 wheelchairs to provide mobility to those in need.

Here's a great 5 minute video of our District at work in Cancun - give it a look: Wheelchair video You can also use this with your club.

There are a lot of things that we take for granted, such as pre-natal care, and technological advancements, that are not as common elsewhere in the world. The results are birth defects, and disabilities among children and adults. We have been able to make distribution trips to over 20 locations in Mexico, and Central America, to personally see the miracle of mobility in action.

We are currently in the process of planning a trip to Mexico City in the spring of 2022 and any Rotarian is invited to go. You can get more info at our booth during District Conference September 18 in Eureka Springs.

Just as a reminder, you can have a profound impact and change a life and the lives of those around the recipient for \$150. These can be purchased by individual Rotarians or your club.
