The **Rotary Club of Bixby** and other District 6110 Clubs are partnering with Colombia District 4271 in order to provide safe drinking water to 49 schools and over 21,000 students in three regions of Colombia. The three Regions are: Santander, Costa Atlantica & Antioquia. The first phase will be in the Santander Region which is only 5 hours from Dallas which makes access to members that want to visit the project very affordable and accessible. We are currently partnering with the Rotary Clubs of Rogers Downtown, Rotary Club of Joplin, Rotary Club of Bentonville and Tulsa Sunrise. Also joining us will be the Rotary club of Bella Vista and the Bentonville Satellite. We are actively looking for other District 6110 Clubs to join us in this project which will also include the construction of bathrooms as well as remodeling existing facilities. Another extremely needed event will be hygiene education. The length of the three phases will be 12 months with a cost of \$181,000.
