BATESVILLE PRESCHOOL OPEN HOUSE

Batesville Preschool will hold open house on Aug. 20 and 21 from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. at 650 Vine St.

*Children whose last names start with A-L are asked to come Aug. 20. *Children whose last names start with M-Z are asked to come Aug. 21.

Only one parent will be allowed to attend with the child, and preschool staff will be taking temperatures of all parents and children. Please bring updated immunization records and any other paperwork needed.

Gov. Asa Hutchinson has issued a statewide order requiring masks at all times for ages 10 and over, except for those who have a physical condition that prevent doing so. Preschool students will not be required to wear a mask.

The preschool's last day of summer school is July 31. The building will be closed until the first day of school, Monday, Aug. 24. For questions, call 870-793-0630.

Batesville Preschool/BSD Home Visiting Office will host a **DIAPER DRIVE** in conjunction with our **OPEN HOUSE** on Aug. 20 and 21. Although open house will be held from 4:30-7:30 p.m., diapers may be dropped anytime that week, from 7:30 a.m.-4 p.m., at the preschool front office.

All diapers collected during this drive will be donated to babies in our community. All sizes are needed and will be greatly appreciated.

Imagine only being able to change your baby's diaper once a day in order to make a package last until your next paycheck. For an average infant, a healthy change of diapers is up to 12 times per day, and 8 for a toddler. For low income families, a baby can be in a single diaper all day long or longer. This increases the risk of skin infection and worse. Currently there is no "safety net" (WIC, food stamps, Medicare (except hospice) that pays for or provides diapers.

1 in 3 families struggle with diaper need. Our mission is to help meet the basic needs of all children including access to clean, dry diapers!

More about PAT:

Batesville Preschool is fortunate to have a Parents as Teachers program here on campus, providing services to children and their families throughout Independence County free of charge. We promote positive parenting, enhance child health and development, prevent child abuse, and prepare children for kindergarten. Activities include monthly home visiting, developmental screening, informational parent meetings, play groups, and connection to community resources.
