ELAINE MASSACRE MEMORIAL Rayman Solomon and David Solomon: The Elaine Massacre, 100th Anniversary



Rayman L. Solomon is University Professor and Dean Emeritus. Prior to that he served as the first Provost of Rutgers ♦ Camden as Dean of the Law School for 16 years. During his time as dean he oversaw the construction of a new law school building, helped reform the curriculum, and established a broad array of pro bono programs. Prior to coming to Rutgers-Camden, Dean Solomon was Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Curriculum at Northwestern University School of Law (1989-1998). Before that he was Associate Director and a Research Fellow at the American Bar Foundation (1980-1989). While there he was also the editor of the American Bar Foundation Research Journal (now Law & Social Inquiry). Dean Solomon graduated with a B.A. from Wesleyan University (1968) and has a J.D. (1976) and a Ph.D. (1986) in American Legal History from the University of Chicago. He served as Director of the Seventh Circuit History Project (1976-1978) and published A History of the United States Court of Appeals, 1891 - 1941 (Government Printing Office, 1981). Dean Solomon served as a law clerk to the Honorable George Edwards, Chief Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit (1978-1979). Dean Solomon's areas of research are the history of the American legal

profession, the history of judicial ethics, and federal court history. Dean Solomon was born in Helena, Arkansas and has been an active member of the Elaine Massacre Memorial Committee.



David Solomon is the CEO and a trustee of the Elaine Massacre Memorial Committee. He is the current managing partner of Solomon Farms, LLC in Phillips County Arkansas. He was previously senior executive, director, and major shareholder of Donovan Data Systems, Inc. serving in that position from 1986-1999.

Mr. Solomon is active as a trustee of the Bronx Freedom Fund; JustLeadershipUSA, director of the Fortune Society, current Compliance Officer and member of the executive team. He serves as a trustee of the William Alanson White Institute of Psychiatry, Psychoanalysis & Psychology and chair of the Beth El Cemetery.

Mr Solomon is a graduate with a MA in History from New York University Graduate School of Arts and Science. He holds a certification as an archivist in New York State. He received his BA from Harvard College and is a PhD candidate American History, ABA.

He served in the U.S. Army, 1st Infantry Division, attaining the rank of E-5. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for Meritorious Service.
