12:00 noon Program: Jennifer O'Brien, Author: *The Hospice Doctor's Widow: A Journal*

Jennifer O'Brien helps people talk about caregiving and end of life. She encourages compassionate, real conversation through her book, *The Hospice Doctor's Widow: A Journal*, where she shares her story of caregiving through collages and writings.

After years of caring for people with serious illness as a physician, Jennifer's husband, Bob Lehmborg, was diagnosed with a stage IV, metastatic cancer. But caregiving for the man who had made a 40-year career of caregiving as a physician was not easy. When Jennifer's husband was diagnosed, she turned to what had brought her comfort for years—art journaling. She documented and depicted the raw, honest, beautiful and exhausting reality of caregiving through collage, tableaux, notes and observations. She included much of the wisdom and perspective she learned from her husband in his years as a physician.

Jennifer earned her Bachelor's degree from Boston University and a Master's in Organization Development from Loyola University - Chicago. Having been a practice management consultant and educator to physicians for 33 years, an executive administrator for two large medical practices here in Little Rock, in administration at three major academic medical centers, the author of 40+ articles in her specialty, the wife and now widow of a physician, Jennifer has a unique and thorough understanding of healthcare. Still, with all of this experience, caregiving for her dying husband was both the greatest honor and challenge of her life.

IMMEDIATE NEED!

CONVALESCENT PLASMA FOR TREATING COVID-19



Your Blood Institute has an immediate need for convalescent plasma from donors who have recovered from COVID-19, as part of an experimental initiative to use the product to treat seriously ill patients.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

To provide convalescent plasma, donors must:

- Have a prior diagnosis of COVID-19, documented by a laboratory test
- Be symptom-free for 14 days prior to donation
- Be 7 days post blood or plasma donation

HOW TO REGISTER NOW:

Sign up today for the registry by visiting bit.ly/covid19-registry or calling 888-308-3924. Positive COVID-19 test results should be faxed to 405-278-3140 or emailed to results@bio-linked.org.

Once qualified, plasma will be drawn, with a single donation providing therapeutic plasma for 2-4 seriously ill patients.
