EXODUS.LIFE

Paul Stevens is the Executive Director of EXODUS.LIFE. A native Arkansan from Little Rock, Paul has spent a lifetime serving the community. He is a graduate of UALR and did post graduate work at John Brown University. Paul started his career operating four homeless shelters. From 1989 to 1997 Paul worked as Director at Union Rescue Mission, where under his leadership the Dorcus House was built-serving women suffering from domestic violence with

clinical services.

In 1997, he joined the staff of Fellowship Bible Church, where he served for twenty years. For ten of those years He led the church to increased ♦social entrepreneurship, ♦encouraging business men in the church to take on social problems. Dozens of successful projects were undertaken, raising millions of dollars for area concerns. He also helped launch **ShareFest**, a local initiative recruiting hundreds of churches, raising money for public schools and local non-profits as well as mobilized thousands of volunteers. The event continued for ten years and eventually spread to cities across the nation. He spent his last 10 years as a member of Fellowship ♦s senior leadership team providing guidance for internal ministries.

Since 1989, Paul has worked directly or indirectly with broken marriages, child welfare, addiction, and the incarcerated. He has raised money, mobilized volunteers and worked hand-on to solve some of the poorer communities most difficult problems. He is married to Margaret and has three children.

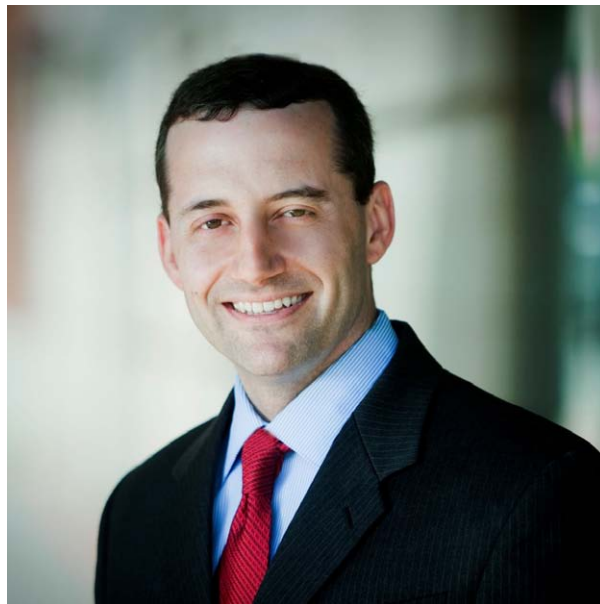
