Director**

Shana has served in the community engagement sector for 30 years, beginning her career in child advocacy and now serving as Director of EngageAR-the Arkansas Service Commission, promoting national service and volunteerism for the state of Arkansas. Before taking a 12 year sabbatical to raise her twin daughters, Shana founded the Arkansas State CASA office, expanding CASA child advocate programs from 3 to 15 in the office's first year. Shana also served as an elected school board member for the Pulaski County Special School District. She has lead multiple teams through organizational and government transformation including rebranding, staff role-shifting, and operations process development/refinement. She is passionate about coaching staff through transitions, aligning staff strengths with organizational needs and building a team culture which balances professionalism, mutual respect, accountability, efficiency and effectiveness with work pride and enjoyment. In her current role, Shana oversees 2.7 million in federal grants and 1.3 million in state and local generated match dollars. Using these funds, Shana and the EngageAR team hope to see statewide issues within the CNCS focus areas of education, health, and economic opportunity significantly impacted through funding and evaluation of evidence based programing.

Shana lives in Maumelle with her husband Paul Chaplin, a Commercial Real Estate Appraiser, 21-year-old twin daughters, and two dogs. Shana volunteers for the Arkansas Community Corrections Department, helping to build out a robust statewide volunteer program. In her spare time, she enjoys reading, long walks and baking.

Shana holds a BA in Criminal Justice, a Certificate in Volunteer Management, and is a graduate of Leadership AR Class XIV.
