## COVID-19 Innoculation Update

The following is information which I have personally found or been given during the last week. Hopefully all is accurate, so please check these items out yourself.

**Biden** President Elect Biden has announced a large push for distribution and inoculations for Covid19. He is seeking \$1.9 billion for Covid relief, of which \$400 billion is for increase in vaccine, distribution and inoculations. We can all hope this helps.

**Current Local Programs** Currently Balboa Baptist church had a sign up program for Covid shots. They announced a signup form Thursday @ 8am to noon on Friday. They were inundated with applications and quit receiving application at 1pm on Thursday. Those who got in will be contacted to set up their appointment time.

Diamonte Country Club is providing inoculations through their membership roles. All Diamonte members over 70 should be receiving calls to set up the appointment time for their shot. (Non members may not sign up.)

Eastgate Pharmacy has been accepting registrations for shots on their website (eastgatepharmacy.com). All you have to do is click the red signup button on their website and fill out their form. They will notify you when they have a shot for you.

**Sentinel Record** The Covid-Innoculation process is slow getting moving, but it appears that local medical resources are beginning to gear up for shots. The Hot Springs Sentinel Record newspaper announced in their January 16th paper the following locations are also accepting applications for innoculation waiting lists.
