## Virtual Walk for Cancer

This year marks the 19th annual Village Walk, and it comes at an unprecedented time as we face a global pandemic. The Village Walk for Cancer Research is a grassroots volunteer initiative of community members who have a passion to raise money for cancer research. Since 2002, the walk raised almost \$736,000 in cash and in kind donations. The proceeds for this year's Village Walk will benefit the Seeds of Science program and be used for cancer research at the Winthrop P. Rockefeller Cancer Institute at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS).

As the state continues to open businesses and resume other activities, our local government and state health officials are monitoring the daily impact of the COVID-19 virus. However, given the number of positive cases in the state, the responsible decision is to take any human contact out of the 19th Annual Village Walk for Cancer Research by making it into a *virtual walk*

What is a virtual walk? It is not much different than our previous Village Walks, except it is on your terms. Just because we can't be together in person, doesn't mean we cannot make a difference in raising money for cancer research. Everyone who registers will receive a T-shirt and can walk, kayak, or bike up to 5 miles at your own pace at times of your choice on Saturday, September 26th (please follow distancing guidelines). We will have the balloon arch up at the Balboa Beach Trail Head for photo opportunities. Make sure you wear your walk shirt!
