Amazon Smiles Accounts

For those not familiar with the method from Amazon which Amazon uses to make charitable donations to Non Profits is called Amazon Smiles. Each one of us can use Smiles to get 0.5% of each members gross purchases (at not cost to the member) as a donation to our Charity Corporation. The following is Melanie Pederson's outline of how to sign up and use Amazon.Smiles as a source of revenue for our Charity Corp. We hope everyone will use this easy method to get some easy money for our charities.

What is AmazonSmile?

AmazonSmile is a simple way for you to support the Rotary Club of Hot Springs Village every time you shop, at no cost to you. AmazonSmile is available at smile.amazon.com on your web browser and can be activated in the amazon shopping app for iOS and Android phones. When you shop AmazonSmile.com, you will find the exact same low prices, vast selection and convenient shopping experience as Amazon.com, with the added benefit that AmazonSmile will donate 0.5% of your eligible purchases to our Rotary Club or another non-profit of your choice.

How do I sign in?

In your browser or phone app, enter <https://smile.amazon.com/>, then enter HSV Rotary Charity Corporation and select it to be your charity of choice. If you are an Amazon or Amazon Prime Customer, you will automatically be linked when you sign into SmileAmazon.com. **Note: The Smile Amazon Smile Link will be orange background with white lettering.**

Is there an Amazon Smile Prime APP for my phone or tablet?

Yes, download the Amazon Shopping App, enter Amazon Smile Prime in the search bar, tap on AmazonSmile is now available in the app, make sure you have selected HSV Rotary Charity Corporation (done at smile.amazon.com), tap continue, read how it works (if you choose to) and tap Got It. The 3 of 3 screen will ask you to turn on receiving notifications and turn on Amazon Smiles. Amazon will Thank you and let you know that you will need to renew AmazonSmile on your device twice a year and give you a renewal date. Don't worry, they will send you reminders. Then start shopping, you will see the AmazonSmile prime logo at the top of your screen.

Can I use my existing Amazon.com account on AmazonSmile? Yes, you use the same account on Amazon.com and AmazonSmile. Your shopping cart, Wish List, wedding or baby registry, and other account settings are also the same.

How do I select a charitable organization to support when shopping on

AmazonSmile? On your first visit to AmazonSmile (smile.amazon.com), you need to select a charitable organization to receive donations from eligible purchases **before** you begin shopping. Our registered name is Hsv Rotary Charity Corporation. AmazonSmile will remember your selection, and then every eligible purchase you make at smile.amazon.com will result in a donation to our club.

How much of my purchase does Amazon donate? The AmazonSmile Foundation will donate 0.5% of the purchase price from your eligible AmazonSmile purchases. The purchase price is the amount paid for the item minus any rebates and excluding shipping & handling, gift-wrapping fees, taxes, or service charges. From time to time, Amazon may offer special, limited time promotions that increase the donation amount on one or more products or services or provide for additional donations to charitable organizations.

What will the HSV Rotary do with the money? The money will go into the HSV Rotary Charity Corporation account to be used for Charity Projects.
