Scholarship Trust Update

Tiffany Tucker, Chairman on the Scholarship Committee, will be updating the club periodically on the scholarship fund. The trust currently has approximately \$166,000 in endowment. This fund is managed by Community First Trust Co of Hot Springs. Last year, the trust, which is invested in a conservative low risk fund, earned 7%.

Each year the trust distributes \$12,000 to the Scholarship Committee, to be used to fund over half of the \$19,000 in scholarships awarded each year.
