Ozark Mission Project sends students to camp sites and churches around Arkansas where they help neighbors that are in need of minor construction and yard work. In Hot Springs they've built wheelchair ramps (42), repaired porches (19), painted houses (55), repaired houses (69) and mowed 66 yards with an economic impact of \$47,764.

Rotarians are people of action. A case in point is the mentoring program set up by Rotary Club of Poplar Bluff, Missouri. This program is designed to help 24 boys and girls, ages 11 to 17, who have had a brush with the law. The Rotarians offer advise on life and careers that are open to these young



people. They currently live in group homes and are members of Interact Club.

For some of them, this is the only chance they have to set their lives on a good course. The meetings with the Rotarians focus on building a resume and preparing for job interviews.

Another example of action by Rotarians takes place with the Rotary Club of Tuscaloosa, Alabama. They charter annual flights to Washington, DC which sends nearly 800 veterans for an expense paid day of visits to the war memorials.
