Mr. Malone, nicknamed the Mailman, is the son of Shirley Malone and the youngest of nine children. He grew up on a farm in Summerfield, Louisiana (less than 50 miles from here). He led Summerfield High School to three consecutive Louisiana Class C titles going on to attend Louisiana Tech in Ruston. Malone began his NBA career with the Utah Jazz in 1985. He remained with the Jazz until 2003 finishing out his career with the L.A. Lakers from 2003-2004.

Malone is considered one of the greatest power forwards in NBA history. He is a two time NBA most valuable player, 14 time NBA all star, 11 time member of the All-NBA 1st team and has the 2nd highest career total points with 36,928 points. He also holds the record for most free throws attempted and made.
