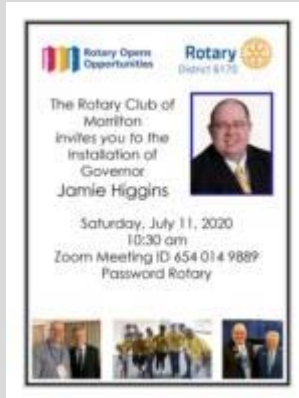

District Grant Proposals Due July 31

District grants are an excellent way to open opportunities for service in your club! This year qualified clubs are allowed to submit a youth focused grant of \$500 and an additional project of up to \$1000. Clubs may also choose to submit a youth focused grant of up to \$1,500 and forgo an additional project. In addition, clubs can combine funds for larger projects but members of all clubs in the grant submission must play a part in the proposal and execution of the project.
