

Dr. Craig McClain -- Guest Speaker



Dr. Craig McClain received his Ph.D. at the University of Massachusetts Boston, and conducted postdoctoral work at the University of New Mexico and Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute. At Duke University, he served as the Deputy Director for the Triangle Center for Evolutionary Medicine and the Assistant Director for Science at the National Evolutionary Synthesis Center. He currently serves as the Executive Director for the Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium.

During his tenure at LUMCON, he has secured \$10 million dollars in grants, a \$110 million regional class research vessel, and over \$30 million dollars in funding for a new joint maritime campus. LUMCON s staff, scientific usage, and student population have also shown significant growth. With over 60 published papers, Dr. McClain s research focuses on areas of biodiversity, climate change, and carbon cycling in coastal and deep oceans. He has participated in and led dozens of oceanographic expeditions taking him to the Antarctic and to the most remote regions of the Pacific and Atlantic. His current research focuses on how energy and metabolism drive the biology of marine organisms from individuals to ecosystems. More specifically, he is seeking to uncover how organisms will respond to

climate change.

Craig s research has been featured on National Public Radio, Discovery Channel, CNN, Fox News, National Geographic and ABC News. In addition to his scientific research, Craig also advocates the need for scientists to connect with the public and is the founder and chief editor of the acclaimed Deep-Sea News (http://deepseanews.com/), a popular ocean-themed blog that has won numerous awards. His writing has been featured in Cosmos, Science Illustrated, American Scientist, Wired, Mental Floss, and the Open Lab: The Best Science Writing on the Web. His forthcoming book, Craig With Big Things, And Small Things explores his obsession with the diversity in sizes of life
