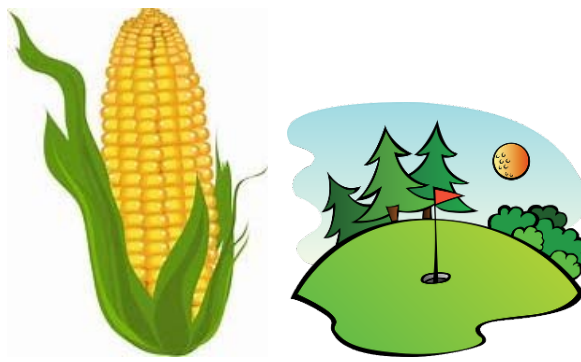
September 9, 2019: Golf Outing and Corn Roast
