JULIE DOBSKI AS DISTRICT GOVERNOR FOR 6490 in 2019-2020



Rotary International District 6490 installed new leadership on June 30, 2019, at the Rotary District 6490 Installation and Gala which was held on the campus of Illinois State University at the Bone Student Center in Normal. Serving as district governor this year is Julie Dobski of Bloomington. Appreciation was given to past district governor, Arlene Pennie of Normal. Dobski will hold the office of district governor from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.



Dobski, a past president of Bloomington-Normal Sunrise Rotary, has served as a local businesswoman and philanthropist for more than 35 years. During her club presidency, Julie added 27 new members and 33 Paul Harris Fellows. Her club received the District 6490 Large Club of the Year Award, the Star Club designation, the Club Service Award, and the R I Presidential Citation. Julie was also named Rotary District 6490 Rotarian of the Year in 2015-2016. She is a member of the Paul Harris Society.
