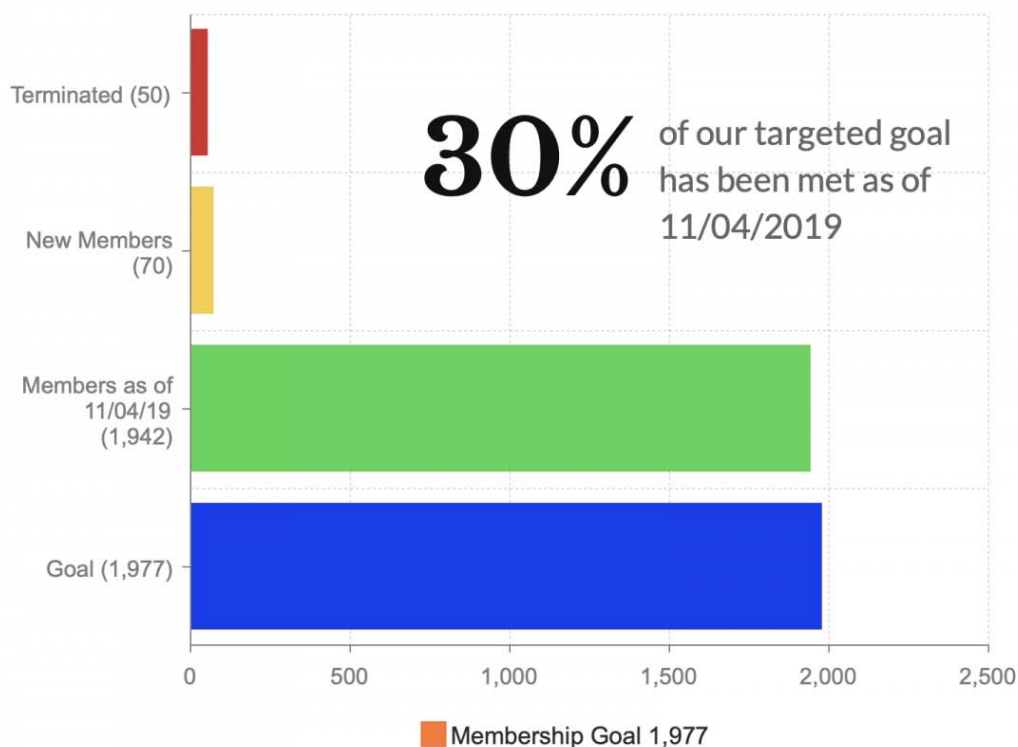

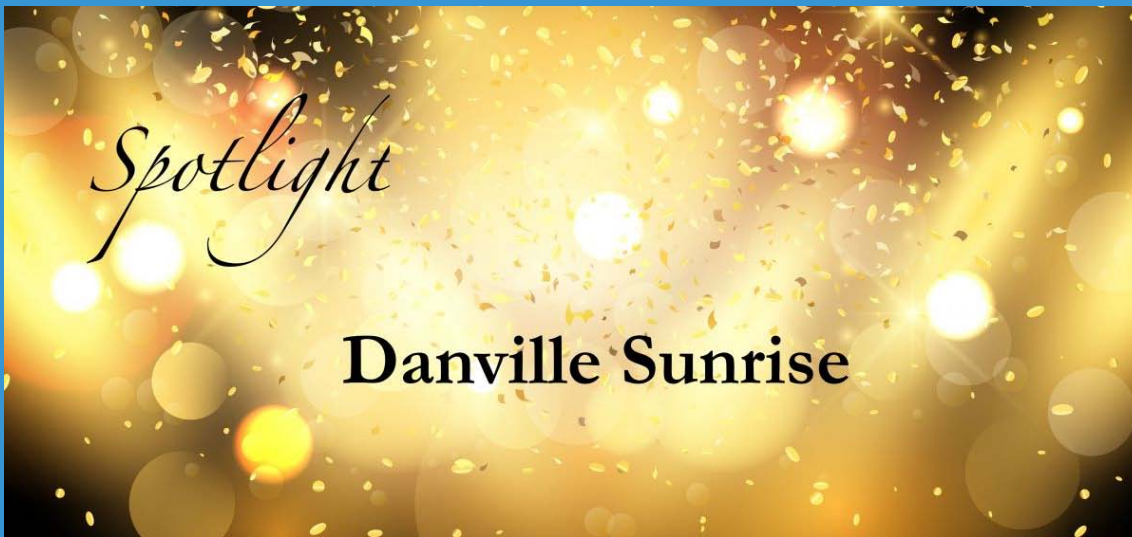
leadership.

Danville Sunrise demonstrated support for each of the R.I. strategic priorities (*support and strengthen clubs, focus and increase humanitarian service, enhance image and awareness*) by completing certain activities, and successfully entered their goals in Rotary Club Central.
