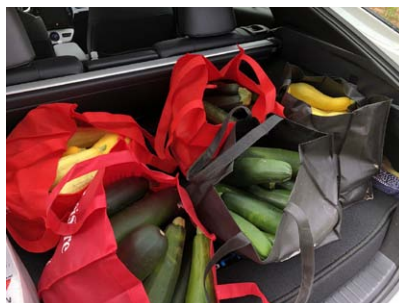


There is still lots to do at the garden, so please head on out to help whenever you can.

The teen survivors Ascent 121 serves often times have suffered extreme traumatic physical and sexual violence that results in layers of hidden wounds. The emotional and mental effects can be persistent and devastating, taking a long time to heal from the abuse. This is why Ascent 121 offers a continuum of services in addition to special therapy options to complement the healing journey of each survivor's unique story.

Kids in the Impact program complete an eight week equine therapy program. These sessions are designed to work on critical life skills such as addressing fear, using your voice, establishing boundaries, and creating trust. The clinical team celebrates the survivors' skills learned through these sessions and seeing them be put into practice through other aspects of their recovery journey.

Art therapists visit with kids in the residential and aftercare programs to use art as a creative way to express their feelings and share their stories in a non-invasive way. This often feels safer and less threatening for the kids.

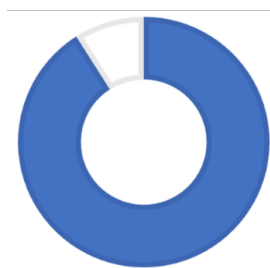
