October 9: Indiana Trafficking Victims Assistance Program



The Indiana Trafficking Victims Assistance Program works to identify and provide comprehensive services to victims (24 and under) of trafficking or sexual exploitation. Within each of the twelve regions, victim services networks will be identified or established to appropriately respond to trafficked victims and/or make appropriate referrals to services, benefits and programs for which they are eligible.

Jessica Herzog-Hall dedicated her academic career to understanding all aspects of what a survivor of violent crime experienced. Jessica served as a Legal Advocate, assisting victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking through the court process. She then served as an intern with the Louisville Special Victims Unit. Assisting the police officers with victim interviews, case organization and arresting offenders. Prior to joining the Indiana Trafficking Assistance Program, Jessica worked at Chaucie's Place as a Prevention Education Coordinator.
