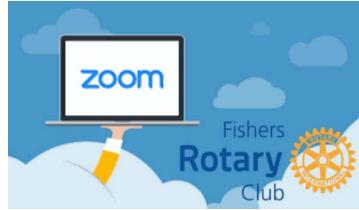

Message from the President

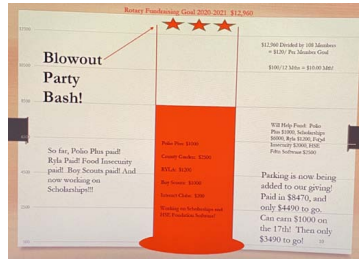
We're getting close!
