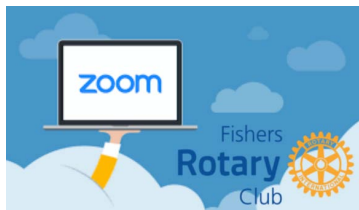

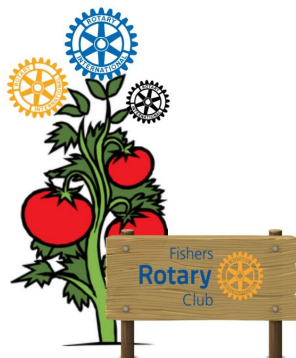

### End of Season Garden Help Needed

As another successful season at the Community Garden comes to a close, we need some final help for the following dates.

- Garden tear out and cleanup** - Saturday, Oct 31st - 9:00 to noon. Please arrive and leave as your schedule allows but please try and give us at least an hour of your time.
  - gloves, square or spade shovel
  - tear out tomatoes
  - stack and secure tomato cages for the winter
  - wash hand tools
  - store temporary irrigation lines in nearby wooded area
- Build two gravel walkways** - Saturday, Nov 7th - 9:00 to noon
  - gloves, garden rake, square or spade shovel
  - laying out 2x4 on path and securing with rebar stakes
  - spread crushed limestone on path and level with garden rakes

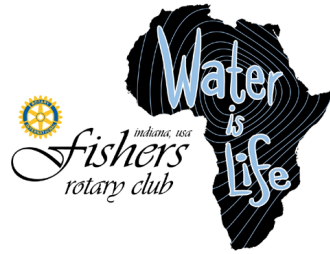
