As another successful season at the Community Garden comes to a close, we need some final help for the

- 1. Garden tear out and cleanup Saturday, Oct 31st 9:00 to noon. Please arrive and leave as your schedule allows but please try and give us at least an hour of your time.
 a. gloves, square or spade shovel
- b. tear out tomatoes
- c. stack and secure tomato cages for the winter
- d. wash hand tools
- e. store temporary irrigation lines in nearby wooded area
- 2. Build two gravel walkways Saturday, Nov 7th 9:00 to noon
- a. gloves, garden rake, square or spade shovel b. laying out 2x4 on path and securing with rebar stakes
- c. spread crushed limestone on path and level with garden rakes
