COVID Vaccine Interest Form



Fishers Health Department Encourages All Residents to Complete COVID-19 Vaccine Interest Form

As Mayor Fadness communicated to our Club during our meeting on January 8th, all residents of Fishers are encouraged to complete a COVID-19 Vaccine Interest Form in anticipation of the Fishers Health Department receiving the COVID-19 vaccine this year. Public Health Director Monica Heltz requests residents to complete the interest form as quickly as possible.

The FHD is prepared to begin distributing vaccines for individuals aged 70+, per the Indiana State Department of Health's priorities list. This grouping joins the current priority group of healthcare and first responders. Individuals who complete the Vaccine Interest Form **and** qualify under these categories will be notified as scheduling becomes available this month.

The purpose of the interest form is to provide information to the Fishers Health Department to assist in the preparations of COVID-19 vaccination distribution. COVID-19 vaccinations are not anticipated to be available to the general public until mid-2021 but certain individuals may qualify to receive the vaccine sooner based on certain criteria. This survey is based on the most current criteria being utilized at the state and national levels for vaccine allocation and may change as new guidance is released to FHD. The City encourages residents to dine safely by taking advantage of reduced-contact services including online ordering, carryout, curbside pickup, drive thru, and delivery.

With only one week left in the challenge, which concludes on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, residents are encouraged to look for every opportunity to give back, from picking up groceries for a neighbor, to holding the door open to a stranger, to donating items to a food pantry or shelter.
